

Yard Waste Guide

Acceptable Items: Grass, Leaves, Tree Limbs, Weeds, Wood Chips, Green Plants, Garden Trimmings, Pine Needles and branches / clean wood 3" diameter or smaller.

Unacceptable Items:

Swamp cooler pads, Cardboard/Paper, Dirt, Rocks, Concrete, Sod, Garbage, Plastic Items, Hazardous Waste, Painted or Treated

Wood. Yard waste packed in plastic, contaminated with any unacceptable items, and/ or overfilled will not be serviced.



Bear Protection

Garbage problems can be solved by securing the lids of the NRWS carts with a ratchet strap, that our drivers will remove on your service day. It is recommended to store carts inside a shed or garage between service days. Freeze food scraps and place in garbage when taking cart to the street for service day.

Don't leave trash, groceries or animal feed in your cart. Keep garbage cans clean and deodorize them with bleach or ammonia. Harvest fruit off trees as soon as it's ripe, & promptly collect fallen fruit. Avoid using bird feeders as they are a powerful attractant. Don't leave any scented products outside, even

non-food items such as suntan lotion, insect repellent, soap or candles. Keep barbecue grills clean. Keep pet food and pets inside. Securely block access to potential crawl spaces under decks and buildings. Keep doors and windows closed and locked as scents can lure bears inside. Consider installing motion-detector alarms, electric fencing or motion activated sprinklers. Remove all food from homes and cabins that will be unoccupied for an extended period of time.
