RECYCLING SAVES!

Here at NRWS we're busy striving for a zero waste world, there are many reasons why everyone should reduce their waste and recycle!

Recycling Saves Resources: Recycling protects the environment and reduces the need to extract virgin materials, including oil. Recycling one ton of plastic saves the equivalent of nearly 4 barrels of oil. Our local recycling efforts help save the equivalent of nearly 13 million gallons of gasoline each year!

Recycling Saves Money: Recycling is more efficient than wasting and costs us all less. Recycling and yard waste collection is included in your service, and your monthly bill is determined by the size of your garbage container. The bigger the trash can, the more you pay...save money by reducing your waste!

Recycling Saves Energy: Each year, about 40,000 tons of materials are recycled or composted by NRWS. By keeping these valuable resources out of the landfill, we significantly decrease carbon dioxide and methane emissions and save enough energy to power all the houses in Paradise for three months!

Recycling Saves Jobs: Did you know that the recycling industry in California employs as many people (85,000) as the film industry? And, for every ton of material that is recycled, instead of wasted in landfills or incinerators, 10 times as many jobs are created in recycling sorting, and 25 times as many jobs are created in recycling manufacturing.

Battery Recycling

Batteries are not allowed into the trash or your recycling can. They are hazardous materials that need to be recycled separately. You can drop off your old household and auto batteries at NRWS Recycling Center Mon -Sat 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. FREE of charge. Please separate battery types (Alkaline, NiCd, Automotive) for easier recycling, and tape the positive (+) terminal on your batteries before dropping off.

BATTERIES: D, C, A, AA, & AAA don't need to be taped – everything else, including rechargeable batteries must have ends taped!



Paying Your Garbage Collection Bill

Regular Billing: Residential bills are sent to customers every three months. Payment is due upon receipt, prompt payments are appreciated, monthly payments and payment arrangements can be made.

Newspaper Recycling

The Rotary Sponsored Bin is now located in the Ace Hardware parking lot on Clark and Pearson.



Drop off all your old newspaper and magazines. All proceeds go to support the Paradise Performing Arts Center. When you donate clean separated paper it isn't subjected to potential contaminants and thus increases its value.
