## Mandatory Commercial Recycling: What You Need to Know



Commercial Recycling is Free for all Businesses

In July 2012, California's Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law AB 341 goes into effect. The law will affect all businesses that generate more than 4 cubic yards of refuse and recyclables per week.

The good news is that 99% of all businesses in Paradise already have the required recycling in place so everyone, with the exception of a handful of businesses, is already in

compliance with the law and will not be negatively effected by it in anyway.

**Did you know** that 60% of all landfill waste is generated by the commercial sector?

However, there is always room for improvement and NRWS is here to help your business increase recycling efforts and reduce operational costs. To help your business to exceed new standards NRWS provides a full time Recycling and Public Outreach Coordinator that is available free to all businesses to perform waste characterization studies, provide data, and calculate possible rate savings, as well as, train staff on recycling do's and don't's. 
# Reducing Contamination Will Keep Recyclables From Going to the Landfill

The first step toward recycling is knowing what can and cannot be recycled. Our cans are color coded to help you easily remember what goes where. Please note that some "White bins" are only for Cardboard and some are for Mixed Recycling.
