FREE SHARPS CONTAINERS / NEW DROP OFF LOCATIONS



The Town of Paradise has been awarded a CalRecycle grant for sharp containers and disposal kiosks. Containers will be available for free at NRWS office Monday - Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. One quart and one gallon containers are available; limit one per customer and while supplies last.

In addition, Paradise will now have 2 new drop off locations for Sharps: Cobblestone Pharmacy 6585 Clark Rd and COVE Recycling 8279 Skyway. Both locations will have a Kiosk on site for Free drop off of sharps and free sharp containers. Please make sure sharps are in an approved container before drop off. Recycling Tip!

Remember that there are laws that prevent placing certain items with a cord into the trash. Items without a circuit board or LED display (i.e. toasters) can go right into your blue cart. All other electronic material can be dropped off Free of Charge Monday - Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the NRWS Recycling Center, 920 American Way, Paradise.
