
Earlier this year rePlanet, California's largest beverage container recycler, closed 191 beverage container-redemption, and recycling centers due to reduced state payments and record declines in

PLAN AHEAD BEFORE DROPOFF

Before heading out to your local recycling center review these tips to make drop off easier and faster.

- 1. Make sure all your beverage containers are emptied and separated by material; aluminum, plastic and glass. For the glass further separate out into color.
- 2. When arriving at the recycling center please note that these facilities are self service, park and check in with an attendant so that they can guide you to the right spot to recycle your items.
- 3. If you have a large item that you need assistance unloading please call ahead to let staff know so they can make the proper arrangements.

The NRWS Recycling Center at 920 American Way, is open Monday through Saturday 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. We buy back all CRV beverage containers and provide free drop off for all Recyclables, Styrofoam, Appliances (Freon items do have a \$15 charge), Electronic Waste, Oil, Antifreeze, Sharps, Scrap Metal and Batteries. The COVE Recycling Center at 8279 Skyway is open seven days a week



from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. for the buyback of all your CRV beverage containers and free drop off for sharps.

Household Hazardous waste items can be dropped off once at week at the Town of Paradise Permanent HHW Facility please see your calendar for correct days.

We develop a plan for your event, which includes recycling, compost and trash services, consult on waste diversion plans, monitor and provide bins, educate attendees, and take all the materials away. On average, we will divert anywhere from 50-99% of waste.



# **HHW FACILITY TIP**

Only fluorescent tubes and CFL's (compact fluorescent lights) contain mercury and must be brought to a HHW facility. Incandescent bulbs, pictured on the left and LED bulbs pictured on the right, go into the trash.
