### TREE RECYCLING

Christmas Trees will be collected <u>during the</u> <u>month of January 2013.</u> Please place your tree inside of your brown cart, **NOT outside it**. Pick up is <u>on your regular service day</u> If your tree is greater than 4 feet in length, please cut it in half, it must fit in the cart with lid closed. Remember to remove all ornaments and metal stands. <u>Flocked trees</u> (<u>those with fake snow on</u> <u>the branches</u>) will not be accepted.

You may also drop off trees, free of charge, during the month of January 2013, at the Town of Paradise Vegetative Waste Facility located at 925 American Way, Paradise. Trees must be clean and no flocked tress will be accepted.

# HOLIDAY TIPS TO REDUCE WASTE AND INCREASE RECYCLING



## ✓ When shopping for gifts bring your own bag.

← <u>*Recycle*</u> baskets, tins or boxes when wrapping gifts

 $\sim$  Try to find tags and cards that are printed on <u>recycled</u>

*paper* or use partial post consumer materials or make your own!



→ Did you know that a lot of wrapping paper is recyclable? However, much of the wrapping paper produced today is made of virigin materials. Consider using reusable

material like newspaper, old sheet music, reusable bags, recycled aluminum foil, etc. And if you do go out and buy wrapping paper keep an eye out for wrapping paper that is made of recyclable material.

↔ Wrap gifts in recycling paper or *get creative* and use magazines or newspaper.

✓ This year, <u>consider a potted</u> <u>tree</u> that can be replanted or a <u>natu-</u> <u>ral tree</u> that has not been flocked so it can be composted.



➤ Did you know that there are laws that prohibit you to throw electronics and hazardous waste in the garbage? As you replace old electronics and batteries it is impostant to remember that these items are hazardous waste and it is illegal to dipose of them in your garbage cart.
