Weekly 3-Cart STARTING JAN 5, 2026 **CURBSIDE SERVICES**

All trash, recycling and compost equipment and service are included in one monthly rate. All curbside services are available weekly. Please call 530-876-3340 for details.

TRASH

Your rate is determined by the size of your gray trash cart – 35, 65, or 95 gallon. The bigger the cart, the more you pay. Save money and resources by reducing your waste.

COMPOST

We provide one brown or green compost cart at no charge. Customers must call to order additional carts — available for a small monthly charge. Place food scraps, soiled paper, and yard trimmings in your compost cart. Only certified compostable bags are accepted in compost carts.



YARD TRIMMINGS: grass, leaves, branches (up to 6" diameter), brush & other plant debris, animal bedding, flowers, pumpkins, holiday greenery, unpainted/untreated wood (less than 36" in length)



FOOD SCRAPS: raw, prepared & cooked food, fruits & vegetables, bread, dairy, meat, bones, grease, eggshells, seafood/shellfish, pet food



SOILED PAPER: paper towels, tissue, coffee filters & grounds, tea bags, waxed paper, butcher paper, certified compostable paper cups, plates & take-out boxes

Please no rocks, dirt, painted wood or cat & dog waste/cat litter.

RECYCLING

We provide one blue cart at no charge. Additional carts are available for a small monthly charge. It is best to put all recyclables loose in your blue cart. Please do not place items in plastic bags-dump the bag!

See inside for examples of items to recycle, compost or landfill.



- ✓ When your cart is full, set it out by 5am on your service day
- ✓ Lid opening should face the street; cart handles should face your home
- ✓ Place at least 2 feet away from other carts and 4−6 feet from other objects (e.g. cars, trees)
- Carts should not obstruct bike lanes or sidewalks
- ✓ All items must be placed in the cart

Did we miss a pickup? Call within 24 hours and we can come back out to service missed carts.



PLEASE NO E-WASTE OR HAZARDOUS WASTE such as batteries, fluorescent lamps/tubes, automotive fluids, pesticides and fertilizers, paint products, cleaners, etc. Check NorthernRecycling.biz for safe and legal disposal options.



SB 1383 is the most aggressive waste reduction law to be adopted in California in the past 30 years. The mandatory law affects almost all California residents and businesses. Cities and Counties will eventually be required to issue penalties for non-compliance.

The law establishes a statewide effort to reduce emissions of greenhouse gases (like methane). By directing food scraps, soiled paper, yard trimmings and other organic materials to compost sites, California communities will significantly reduce greenhouse gases that come from landfills.

SB 1383 also helps cut food waste and food insecurity. The law's requirement of edible food recovery helps feed those who are food insecure and prevents edible food from being landfilled.

How does SB 1383 impact each of us?

At work and at home, we'll need to keep all our recycling and compost materials separate from our trash, in appropriately colored carts.



Northern Recycling provides residents living in single-family homes three colored carts when they start their recycling, compost, and landfill services. If you do not yet have carts for these three services, please contact Northern Recycling to get started. Weekly all 3-cart curbside services begins Jan 5, 2026.
