- ✗ Trash
- ✗ Cardboard



## Not Recyclable:

Not everything belongs in your recycling cart—items like garden hoses, tarps, and sheet plastic should go in the trash.



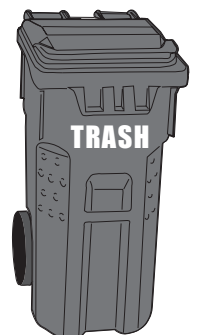

## Carts Must Be Out on Time & Properly Placed

- Please have carts out by 5 a.m. on your pickup day.
- Only carts assigned to your address will be serviced.
- Place carts curbside without blocking the roadway.
- Keep carts at least 3 feet apart and away from vehicles, fences, and mailboxes.
- Do not overload carts; lids must be fully closed.  
*Extra materials must be scheduled in advance & may incur a fee.*
- Return carts to your property after service; *carts may remain at the roadside for no longer than 24 hours.*
