belong in Compost/Organics.*

Not everything belongs in your organics or recycling cart—items like garden hoses, tarps, and sheet plastic should go in the trash.



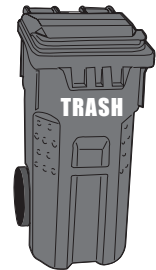
Garden Hose



Sheet Plastic

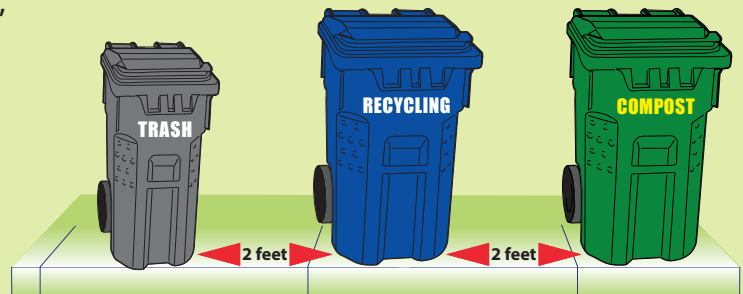

Carts Must Be Out on Time & Properly Placed

- Please have carts out by 5 a.m. on your pickup day.
- Only carts assigned to your address will be serviced.
- Place carts curbside without blocking the roadway.
- Keep carts at least 3 feet apart and away from vehicles, fences, and mailboxes.
- Do not overload carts; lids must be fully closed. *Extra materials must be scheduled in advance & may incur a fee.*
- Return carts to your property after service; *carts may remain at the roadside for no longer than 24 hours.*

The marked 2026 holidays will result in the following service schedules for those weeks:

Memorial Day — Monday, May 25th: services will not be impacted, normal collections will occur.

Thanksgiving — Thursday, November 26th: we will be closed. Each service day will occur 1 day after normal for this week only. Thursday's services will occur on Friday; Friday's on Saturday.

Christmas — Friday, December 25th: we will be closed. Friday's service will occur on Saturday.

New Years — Friday, January 1st, 2027: we will be closed. Friday's service will occur on Saturday.

RCC — Recurring payments run on the second Thursday of the billing cycle. Standard quarterly customers will be debited in January, April, July, and October, while monthly customers will be debited each month.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Improper disposal can pollute water, harm wildlife, and lead to fines. The Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility safely handles unusable hazardous products. Pack items carefully to avoid leaks. The facility accepts all hazardous waste **except**:

NO RADIOACTIVES * NO EXPLOSIVES * NO AMMUNITION

HAZARDOUS WASTE INCLUDES:

- ✓ **METAL:** Air compressors, barometers, CO2 cylinders and cartridges, fire extinguishers, helium, and propane
- ✓ **CONSTRUCTION:** Asbestos, electrical switches & relays, fluorescent ballasts, freon, paint, paint thinners, painted wood, treated wood
- ✓ **MEDICAL:** Inhalers, medicine, needles and sharps, oxygen tanks, thermometers
- ✓ **HOUSEHOLD:** batteries, camping gas cylinders, cleaning products, drain opener, fluorescent lightbulbs, garden chemicals, kerosene, poisons, pool & hot tub chemicals, shoe polish, solvents, and thermostats
- ✓ **MISC ITEMS:** e-cigarettes, musical greeting cards, pepper spray and smoke detectors
